The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m.

Burial Grounds Operable Unit

Payne provided information, regarding grouping of the Burial Grounds Operable Unit (BGOU), in the draft Risk-Based End State document. Russell said he would provide a BGOU presentation to the Board in July or September.

C-746-U Landfill Permit Modification

Lamb updated the task force on the C-746-U Landfill Permit Modification. He stated the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) had requested the modification to include non-hazardous spill cleanup residue. He said there is 3,500 to 4,000 tons awaiting disposal pending approval. Lamb stated the Kentucky Department of Waste Management (KDWM) held a public hearing on May 11, 2004; DOE had provided comments on the draft permit to KDWM at this meeting. DOE is now awaiting approval of the major modification hopefully by mid-June.

Russell requested a new/revised timeline for completion of the currently fenced portion of the C-746-U Landfill and for “expansion” to the remainder of the permitted area at the July task force meeting. Tanner suggested the presentation cover the following issues:

- Current status
- Design
- Projected completion of the first 11 cells
- Proposed preparation for use beyond the fence
- Rate of fill

Workplan Setting

Tanner suggested adding C-746-U Landfill to the Workplan.

Other

Tanner said it was decided at the Chairs meeting that a Public Involvement Workshop would be held at one of the sites. He said the sites would establish a list of recommendations to DOE regarding the Environmental Management program as it relates to public involvement. Tanner asked the task force if they would be interested in hosting this workshop. Russell said he would be interested in the regulatory requirements for public involvement. Dollins said the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Liability and Compensation Act and the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act process is integrated in the Federal Facility Agreement and DOE goes beyond the requirements for public participation.
