Dihel gave presentation on the current status of authorized limits, and how the new limits were developed.

Wheeler asked for more detail on how cleanup costs would be reduced with the new limits implemented. Dihel explained that the new limits would increase the amount of material that could be put into the landfill instead of having to ship it offsite.

Morgan comments that the dollars saved by waste going into the landfill instead of a CERCLA cell would be incorporated into the development of a CERCLA cell.

Wheeler asks if there is a chance of running out of room at the landfill here. Dihel says that we would just expand the landfill footprint.

Wheeler asked if the principals used to come up with the new authorized limits were being used at other sites. Dihel said that they were.
