Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant Citizens Advisory Board Executive Committee Meeting Minutes December 10, 2012

The Citizens Advisory Board (CAB) met at the Environmental Information Center (EIC) in Paducah, Kentucky on Monday, November 12th at 3:00 p.m.

Board members present: Ralph Young, Ben Peterson, Mike Kemp (call in), Buz Smith (call in), Joe Walker (call in), Eric Roberts (call in), and Jim Ethridge

1. Current news and issues
 - ***Smith** complimented LATA and EHI for the job they did coordinating the site tour the previous week. **Roberts** reported on the Board application process for membership renewal that some of the members had to do. He said that **Morgan** and **Coleman** were indicating they might not re-apply to be on the Board. **Roberts** also reported that any upcoming plans for another summit meeting would be driven by Chad Chancellor and Charlie Martin of Paducah Economic Development.

3. Sub-committees
 - Waste Disposal Options - ***Young** said that the site tour from the previous week was a good experience and valuable for the members that attended, especially the newer members that were on the tour. **Roberts** indicated that the feedback from the members were very positive. He also said that the next step for this subcommittee would be a technical discussion of the project.
 - C-400 - ***Roberts** indicated that he thought that the subcommittee meetings in January 2013 were to include a report to this subcommittee. **Young** said that it would be good to have the Groundwater Success Story finished to show the other sites during the spring Chairs meeting in April 2013. **Walker** said he would check the status of the story, but thought **Nichols** was waiting review of the work. **Smith** indicated that he would check on the status of the review.
 - Burial Grounds - ***Kemp** reported that the subcommittee's last meeting was very informative for everyone and more information was being collected.
 - Historic Preservation - ***Peterson** said that the subcommittee was waiting on a review of the book before releasing it to be published. **Smith** said he had talked with the DOE attorney about the legalities of publication, and that person was working on making sure it was acceptable to let the publishing company produce the book.
