The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m.

**Draft Citizens Advisory Board Annual Report**

The task force reviewed the draft document and made several changes. Raper suggested including support staff information and short biographies on all board members. The task force agreed. The final draft text-only version with edits incorporated will be provided to the board at the October 15 meeting.

Color copies of the six possibilities for the cover of the report were reviewed. The task force chose its top two covers. Board members will have an opportunity to vote on a cover at the October 15 board meeting.

**Draft DOE Site Transition Framework for Long-Term Stewardship**

After reviewing the draft document, Raper stated the framework covered all of the necessary issues in a broad general sense. The deadline to submit comments is October 18. Tanner stated the deadline does not provide enough time for the board to discuss and respond. The task force expressed concerns regarding accountability. They want assurance that an Environmental Management office will exist, post-closure, to ensure the details of the Long-Term Stewardship Plan are implemented at the Paducah facility. The task force plans to discuss this issue further at the upcoming Chairs' meeting in Oak Ridge. A copy of the framework document will be provided to the Board in their October meeting packets.
