The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m.

Burial Grounds Operable Unit

Clayton presented additional information on the Burial Grounds Operable Unit (BGOU) the task force had requested. Russell said the task force will review the information and return with questions at the following meeting.

S&T Landfill Recommendation Update

Russell stated copies of the recommendation to discontinue the S&T Landfill Site Investigation had been issued to the Kentucky Department for Environmental Protection and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. He said the Board wanted to ensure that these agencies were fully aware of the action taken by the Board due to the time critical nature of this recommendation. Dollins stated that the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) would respond to the recommendation after a response was obtained from the regulatory agencies.

NSDD Sections 3, 4, and 5 Recommendation Update

Dollins stated DOE would provide a response to the North-South Diversion Ditch (NSDD) Sections 3, 4, and 5 recommendation in early March. He said he believed the recommendation would be accepted.

C-746-U Landfill Update

Russell asked if the authorized limits waste is going into the C-746-U-Landfill. Newtown said yes, specifically NSDD project waste. Dollins stated approximately 700 out of 1,330 burrito bags, containing excavated soil from Section 2 of the NSDD, have been disposed in the landfill.

Newtown said a response was received from the Commonwealth of Kentucky on the major permit modification that will allow acceptance of spill cleanup residue.
