The Water Quality task force will ask the full Board for approval to issue a recommendation to DOE requesting that plans are incorporated within the scheduled C-400 field application to accommodate possible future contaminate rebounding effects, e.g., leaving the equipment in place during an extended period for groundwater monitoring of the C-400 area. The task force believes this approach may result in substantial cost savings in the event that rebounding occurs and necessitates reapplication of direct heating technology.
