Agenda Items

- End State Water Quality
 - Discussed acceptable residential vs. industrial risk
 - Posed the following Water Policy questions:
 - Is there a time limit for the Water Policy?
 - If a house is built in the Water box, does the resident automatically receive free water from DOE?
 - Who qualifies for the Water Policy, what are the boundaries, and how were the original boundaries determined?
 - After plant shuts down, new industrial tenants should have a no-fault clause
Does EM mission for CAB include re-industrialization of the site? Smart requested that Dollins discuss with Murphie and define how far CAB should go with end state discussion.
 - DOE acquisition of property rights (land buyout)
- Southwest Plume Site Investigation
 - 30-day extension, new date for D2 is scheduled for 12/6/05
- Surface Water Operable Unit On-Site Phase I Update
 - Discussed storm water sampling; completing third week – Lee suggested sampling during a wet period
