Agenda Items

- Southwest Plume Site Investigation (SI) update – Dollins said the D2 Site Investigation/Risk Assessment Report would be submitted to the regulators on April 18, 2006.
- C-400 Source Removal Update – Dollins said the Remedial Design Work Plan was released in December 2005. Due to a funding shortfall, DOE has proposed to the regulators to adjust the fieldwork date to the end of the fiscal year.
- Surface Water Operable Unit (SWOU) On-Site Update – Phases 1 and 2 are complete. DOE is discussing with regulators that Step 3 may not be warranted in the storm sewers. Data validated and the risk assessment indicates what actions may be taken at hot spots in other areas.
- C-746-U Landfill Update – Cells 1-3 are close to being full. DOE is waiting for the permit modification to connect the leachate system to cells 4 and 5. Dollins said modification should be approved in mid-March.
- Land Use Maps – Dollins and Bechtel Jacobs Company LLC (BJC) will provide an end state map, a current map and overlaps identifying groundwater contamination, burial grounds/landfills, and monitoring wells at the next task force meeting.
