**Agenda Items**

- Election of Chair – Bobby Lee was elected Chair of the task force by acclamation.
- Southwest Plume Site Investigation (SI) update – Dollins said the D2 Site Investigation/Risk Assessment Report would be submitted to the regulators by May 17, 2006.
- C-400 Source Removal Update – Dollins said the Design Characterization report has been approved by the Commonwealth of Kentucky. Under CERCLA requirements, fieldwork must begin by November 9.
- Surface Water Operable Unit (SWOU) On-Site Update – Dollins said the project is in the report phase where the sampling events are being summarized.
- C-746-U Landfill Update – Dollins said Cell 1 is full and Cells 2 and 3 will be full in mid-April. DOE is working to connect the leachate system to Cells 4 and 5.
- Land Use Maps – Dollins and Bechtel Jacobs Company LLC (BJC) provided a current map and overlays identifying groundwater contamination, burial grounds/landfills and monitoring wells. Lee suggested asking all Board members for ideas on the overlays. Russell asked for existing residences be added to the map.
