#### 1. Review DOE request for additional information on Recommendation 10-07, PGDP Site Museum

DOE requested additional information concerning the CAB's vision for a Site Museum and CAB's vision for preserving artifacts from the production facility. The committee came to consensus on DOE storing all potential artifacts on site until a clear historic preservation vision is defined. The committee agreed to compose a recommendation stating such. *Peterson* suggested defining a potential Heritage Center as part of expanded DOE vision to include research facilities, business offices, and a learning complex as part of a joined Future Use. *Cantrell* stated Reinhard Knerr, DOE Site Lead, has asked Smith and Cantrell to help bring several separate Future Use projects into one manageable "bailiwick". *Clayton* suggested drafting a new recommendation laying out the groundwork for a learning center.

#### 2. Review Draft Historic Outline

The committee used Peterson's draft Historic Outline as a starting point for future discussions. The committee requested continued updates from KRCEE on the progress of their Historic Preservation projects (document and video). Peterson, as chair, made a formal request for these updates to continue. *Bonczek* discussed the committee meeting with Beverly Quimby, WKCTC Videography director, to see what work her department has done in the past and to see the proposed storyboards for the documentary project. *Seifert* encouraged the committee to be demanding customers. A potential recommendation to create a searchable photo archive was also discussed briefly.

#### 3. Lindell Ormsbee - KRCEE Update

Ormsbee updated the committee on the status of the PGDP Future Vision project. Currently 300 distinct contacts have been made at various points in the visioning process. KRCEE's draft deliverable report is due to DOE at end of February, with the final document due at the end of March. CAB will receive a full briefing at the March Board meeting.

Ormsbee then updated the Video/ Oral Histories Project. WKCTC is in the process of assembling an oral history and a video documentary of the PGDP. KRCEE is working on the historical document, most likely in book format. Video History has a target due date of August 2011. There are some issues revolving around security clearance, but KRCEE is working closely with DOE to offset these concerns.

*Bonczek* mentioned the USEC Virtual Museum that is being developed in Portsmouth. DOE will contact Jack Williams, project director, to get a password to access the site since it is still being developed. The committee also discussed sponsoring a public meeting or workshop to help promote the findings of the KRCEE Future Vision project. The committee also discussed bi-weekly calls to stay updated on the KRCEE project. It was recommended that calls take place after 5:00pm and that they be coordinated with the project timeline.

Similarly, Ohio University will hold public meetings March 15 in Chillicothe and March 17 in Portsmouth to launch their visioning program.

The committee then viewed the trailer for the film "Secret City". A documentary based on the war years in Oak Ridge, TN. The committee requested that the full movie be purchased to view as an example of potential documentaries for the Paducah site. *Cantrell* also mentioned the Portsmouth historical video, the PRS introductory video and the USEC Fifty Year anniversary video.

The committee agreed to meet again to further these discussions. A tentative date of Tuesday, March 1, 2011 at 5:30 was chosen as a time to meet with the team from WKCTC and review the PORTS Virtual Museum.
