



Manager's Minute October 29, 2013

Project Updates

C-410—We continue to progress toward achieving demo-ready status by December 30. Asbestos wire removal is ongoing in four remaining zones, two of which are more than half finished. Portions of three mezzanines are being removed to access asbestos wire and/or process equipment. Pending DOE approval, flowable fill work is expected to start November 6 in two basement areas.

C-400—This week, we anticipate having the belowground electrodes and treatment system operating 24/7. The average temperature is now over 130 degrees toward a goal of 190 degrees, with more than 150 gallons of TCE removed. Last week, the aboveground treatment system ran nonstop with electrodes operating on day shift and ambient air/water treatment being used at night.
