

MINOR MODIFICATION

Pursuant to Section XXXIX (Modification of Agreement) of the FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT (FFA) for the Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant, signed on February 13, 1998, and subsequently amended, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 4, the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), and the Kentucky Department for Environmental Protection (KDEP) hereby modify the FFA to extend the time period for informal dispute resolution as described in Section XXV, Resolution of Disputes. This FFA Modification is limited to the informal dispute related to the *Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study Report for CERCLA Waste Disposal Alternatives Evaluation at the Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant, Paducah, Kentucky*, DOE/LX/07-0244&D2 (RI/FS) invoked on May 19, 2014.


The current time period for resolution of informal dispute ends August 17, 2014. As agreed among EPA, KDEP, and DOE on July 29, 2014, the FFA is modified to extend the time period by thirty (30) days. With the 30 days, the FFA parties have until September 16, 2014, to continue discussions as part of the informal dispute process. This time period extended in this Modification shall not be changed except by an additional modification. All other terms and conditions of the FFA remain unaffected by this Modification.
