

# Swift & Staley's current DOE deal extended

The U.S. Department of Energy's Office of Environmental Management has extended the current infrastructure support services contract of Swift & Staley Inc. at the Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant for 2 1/2 months.

Swift & Staley's contract was set to expire Tuesday.

The \$8.4 million extension allows the transition to Swift & Staley's new contract, which was awarded June 17, to occur without interrupting ongoing services, according to the DOE.

Ongoing services to be performed by Swift & Staley during the extension include surveillance, maintenance and repair of facilities; janitorial services; grounds maintenance; roadway/parking lot maintenance; pest control; computing and cyber security; fleet, property and records management; security; health and safety; and training services.

The DOE's current mission is to complete the safe cleanup of the plant following five decades of nuclear weapons development and government-sponsored nuclear energy research.
