Division of Waste Management Announces Grant Recipients

FRANKFORT, Ky. (June 30, 2016) – The Energy and Environment Cabinet (EEC) today announced that up to \$500,000 in grant funding has been awarded for rubber-modified asphalt projects utilizing crumb rubber manufactured from waste tires. The grant funding will be used for the application of chip seal to county roads. Chip seal is a road surface treatment that combines one or more layers of asphalt with one or more layers of fine aggregate, and can extend the life of a road up to eight years...[Continue reading](#)
