Harmful Algal Bloom Prompts Health Warning for Hardinsburg Lake

FRANKFORT, Ky. (July 22, 2016) – The Kentucky Division of Water (DOW) and the Kentucky Department for Public Health (KDPH) have issued a harmful algal bloom (HAB) recreational public health warning for the lake located at the FFA Leadership Training Center, in Hardinsburg, Ky. The recreational public health warning area includes the entire lake.

Water ingested during recreational activities in this lake may increase the risk of gastrointestinal symptoms such as stomach pain, nausea, vomiting and diarrhea. Skin, eye and throat irritation and/or breathing difficulties may also occur after contact...[CONTINUE READING](#)
